

**CANTONMENT BOARD LANSDOWNE**  
**PUBLIC NOTICE FOR ELECTION**  
**(Under Rule 20 of the Cantonment Electoral Rules,2007)**

**WHEREAS**, the Central Government, in exercise of powers conferred under section 15(1) of the Cantonments Act, 2006 has vide gazette notification SRO 09(E) dated 03.11.2014 notified 11<sup>th</sup> January 2015 as the date on which elections to Cantonment Board Lansdowne shall be held.

**NOW** the Cantonment Board Lansdowne in pursuance of the said gazette notification SRO 09(E) dated 03.11.2014 of the Central Government under the provisions of Rule 20 of the Cantonment Electoral Rules,2007 sets out hereunder:-

20 The following symbols may be chosen by the Candidates subject to the conditions that the choice of symbols expressed by the contesting Candidates in their nomination papers shall be considered and decided by the Returning Officer in accordance with rule 31 of the Cantt Electoral Rules, 2007, and the decision of the Returning Officer shall be final :-

Six persons will be elected as members of the Cantt Board from each Ward ( No. I, II, III, IV, V and VI).. Ward No II and V are reserved for Woman Candidates only.

The nomination papers will be presented to the Returning Officer at the Cantonment Board Office on the date and time fixed above.

The scrutiny and objections to the nomination papers, if any, will be held at the Cantt Board Office on the date and time fixed above.

Attention of the public is invited to the Cantt Electoral Rules 2007 which govern the election of the members to the Board. Copies of the Rules are not available for sale but may be obtained from the publication Branch, Govt of India, Delhi on payment. However, the same can be seen in the Cantt Board Office.

Only the nominees, their duly authorized election agents and their proposer may be present at the time of the scrutiny of nomination papers and objections by the Returning Officer on the date, time and place mentioned above.

Nomination papers may be obtained from the office of the Cantonment Board during working hours on any working day. Form of application for inclusion of names in the electoral rolls can also be obtained from the Office of the Cantt Board during the time prescribed above.

Each Candidate with his nomination paper shall deposit or cause to be deposited with the Returning Officer a sum of Three Thousand rupees in cash. In case of Candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe, the amount of deposit shall be Rupees One thousand five hundred only. Provided that where more than one nomination paper is presented, one deposit only shall be sufficient.
