RESOLUTIONS

1. PROGRESS OF MINUTES OF LAST MEETING:

To note and action taken/ is being taken on 24 resolutions adopted in the Ordinary Board meeting held on 30-05-2016. The concerned reports where actions have been taken are also placed on the table.

RESOLUTION: Noted and confirmed. Further, resolved that the ACRs be initiated for the employees of the Cantt Board Lansdowne.

Further, also resolved the followings:-

- a) that the work above the cost of Rs. 50,000/- be carried after approval of the Board only.
- b) that the work in each ward will be carried out equally but in some wards the work amount may be in higher side considering the population and importance of the ward. Provided that the CEO may initiate emergency and urgent works after getting approval of the PCB on notesheet.
- c) A list of the tenants rented by the HOR's be prepared and if found crowded more than capacity of the house, notices be issued to such owners. The police verification also required of such tenants as well as workers engaged by the contractors. The RI will put up in every Board the list of tax and non-tax collection. The RI is hereby directed to watch progress on these matters strictly.
- d) Compliances of the work orders must be concluded within specified time and if any contractor does not complete the work within time he must have to obtain extension as per clauses of agreements executed between both the parties otherwise penalty clause be imposed on the contractor for late compliance of work as per agreement.
- e) The bricks lying at Sadar Bazar area of Sh. Sandeep Bisht, contractor, Cantt Board be shifted for fixing to another places. List be obtained from the ward members and if any ward member does not submit his list than it will be fixed by the discretion of the CEO.
- f) The technical advice of GE be taken on original works/major works.
- g) The AE, Cantt Board, presented the list of works which are running and completed.
- h) Public toilets where water connection does not exist be provide as soon as possible. The possibilities for solar lights be explored in public toilets.
- i) Shri Sachidanand Bharti be called to accelerate the work faster and for their expert advice on the work of Chal Khal.
- j) The tender be invited to install sign boards indicating Lansdowne market at 1) MES crossing, 2) near Officer's MESS, 3) Khaiber Pass, 4) Club Road and 5) near Cantt office. A survey be conduct to install other radiant determination boards.
- k) Urinal be constructed at the place at corner of Cinema hall road and Gandhi Chowk road. The AE already pointed out that there will be blind curve due to proposed construction for road coming from cinema hall. It is further resolved that suitable design (consisting 02 male and 01 female urinal) for the purpose with all technical measures be put up before the Board for approval.
- l) Initiate resumption of the building/plots leased out to the Central/Stat Govt. who are not using the same for the purpose it was leased out.

3. **INVESTMENT OF CANTT FUND ACCOUNT**

A sum of **Rs. 1,99,00,000/-** has been invested in better interest of the Board in higher interest rates with various banks from the Cantt Fund Account based on quotations received from 04 commercial/nationalized banks. As these amounts was not immediately required. The details of the investment are placed on the table for consideration and note.

RESOLUTION: Noted

4. **SANITATION:**

To consider and note sanitary reports for the month of May 2016 submitted by AHO as required under section 131 of Cantt Act 2006, are placed on the table. General sanitation of the area was found satisfactory.

RESOLUTION: Noted and further resolved that improvement in sanitation is required for the purpose SI instructed to regular check up of sanitation of the Cantonment area.

Further resolved that:-

- a- One compact area be select to outsource on trial basis in first instance for cleaning and sweeping.
- b- Waste pipes, downpipes of the houses, hotels, and restaurants should be connected properly in drainage system manner. The S.I. Cantt Board will inspect survey of such untreated sewage systems and will issue notices to concerned defaulters, and fine be imposed, if required.
- c- Tender be called to carry public receptacles, depots or places for temporary deposit wastes and disposal of house hold rubbish, offensive matters, carcasses of dead animals and sewage from the places provided by the Board to the trenching ground and its disposal at trenching ground.
- d- Periodical check up of the workers engaged by hotels/restaurant/sellers of eatable items shall be ensured by the SI that medical examination of the employee done or not and if found without medical examination, the kitchen of the restaurants and other such kind of shops, stalls be sealed immediately after following proper rule/law position.
- e- Stray cattles be sent to Krishnayan Gaushala, Gaindi Khata, Haridwar. The SI will also check and make arrangements to reduce the nuisance of stray dogs and steps to take removal of pigs after giving first notice to concerned keepers, fine be imposed, if required.

5. **HOSPITAL REPORT:**

The Cantonment General Hospital health report for the month of May & June 2016 and Quarterly report are placed on the table for consideration and noting.

RESOLUTION: Noted. Further, resolved that efforts be made to improve the quality of medical facility and services provided by the medical employees. Also resolved, that 01 more ECG machine with 12 lead, 01 three part differential haematology Analyzer and atleast 02 Dengue kit be purchased for the Cantt General hospital. Call quotation for the same.

6. **PROMOTION TO THE POST OF HEADMASTER**

Smt. Sushila Khankriyal has retired on 31 May 2016 from the post of Headmistress of the Cantt Board Primary School Kalagarhi. Consequently, the post of Headmaster is vacant w.e.f 01-06-2016. Sh. Rakesh Yadav, Asst. Teacher, CB Primary School Lansdowne, is only the permanent Asst. Teacher and being senior most he may be promoted to the post of Headmaster w.e.f 01-06-2016 holding the temporary charge of Headmaster vide Office Order Part II No. 221 dt 31 May 2016.

It is submitted that, there is no disciplinary action is pending and contemplated against him.

Office note and concerned files are placed on the table for consideration.

RESOLUTION: Sh. Rakesh Yadav, senior most Assistant Teacher of primary school is promoted in the post of Headmaster w.e.f. 01-06-2016 and financial benefit be accorded.

7. CONSTRUCTION OF SIGNAGE AT LANSDOWNE

Reference letter received dated 16-06-2016 from Paryatan Vikas Parishad Dehradun, Uttarakhand that they have selected Lansdowne to establish a single 4x4 meter Signage erection at Lansdowne at some terms and conditions that the Cantt Board will not take any rent and cost of Land. The proposed signage drawing is also placed along with the mentioned letter. The total construction cost of signage will be borne by the concerned department of Uttarakhand Govt. They need suitable place at Lansdowne for its erection at free of cost.

To consider and decide on the subject letter enclosed.

RESOLUTION: Considered and decided that the proposal be rejected as the requisite land of mentioned size at mentioned places is not available with Cantt Board.

8. RESULT OF BOARD EXAMINATION OF HIGH SCHOOL :

RESOLUTION: An explanation letter be asked from the Principal, Cantt Board High School regarding downward result of 10th Board examination. Further, resolved that the SMC President be requested to improve the examination result of the Cantt Schools in future.

9. FIVE SECURITY GUARDS FOR THE CEO'S BUNGALOW/OFFICE PROTECTION

It is submitted that there is no security guards provisioned for the CEOs bungalow so far. It is being felt that security guard is required to secure the CEOs bungalow. The security guard may be engaged through outsourcing agency at the minimum rate of wages. The total approximate expenditure per month Rs. 50,000/-.

To consider and decide.

RESOLUTION: The CEO, Cantt Board required security guards for protection of Cantt Fund properties due to incidence came to the notice of the CEO when a procession of ABVP, Kotdwara came in the office regarding parking charges and other related issues and processions of local public comes time to time in the office therefore, it is felt that security guard are required to control the situations. The matter discussed in length but the Vice President, Cantt Board become adamant to not to accord the sanction. Then the Board decided that other Cantts be asked is there any provisions for security guards to protect the Cantt Fund properties or handle such kind of situations.

10. UPGRADATION OF GRADE PAY OF LAB TECHNICIAN

Reference application of Sh. Bharat Pal Singh, Lab Technician dated 17-06-2016.

The State Govt. vide their G.O. No. 3P/Para/L.T./5/6/2015/20001 dt 14-08-2015 has upgraded Pay band and Grade pay of their Lab Technician. As per Memorandum of Settlement between Cantt Board and workmen on 13th May 1969 and NIT Award Notification the 4th March 1960 of MoS Para 4,7,14, the Cantt Board employees are also entitled to get same pay and allowances as are applicable to the State Govt. employees in their State in which the Cantt Board is situated.

The relevant G.Os of Uttarakhand State Govt. applicable to the employee are entitled to get pay band Rs. 9300-34800 Grade Pay Rs. 4200/- as upgraded from Rs. 5200-20200 Grade Pay Rs. 2800/- as he is presently receiving.

RESOLUTION: Considered and recommended to grant upgraded Payband Rs. 9300-34800 and grade pay 4200/- w.e.f 17-12-2015 and proposal be sent to competent authority for obtaining sanction. Rs.

11. PARKING

The people were invited at office in “LANSDOWNE MANN KI BAAT” on 29-06-2016, the general public of Gumkhal, Kotdwara, Rikhnikhal, Satpuli etc. sides attended the meeting and raised the questions that;

The parking fee imposed Rs. 2/- per day on commercial taxis like Gumkhal, Kotdwara, Rikhnikhal, Satpuli, Deriyakhal, etc be exempted has the Board already charging vehicle entry fee from them, because of most of the vehicles coming to toll post of Deriyakhal and Jaiharikhal and then few vehicles entering into Lansdowne Cantt. Due to which the people are facing many transport problems;

They also want the taxi vehicle for above mentioned places should be parked below Lans View Hotel at least 14 taxis at a time. Presently they are authorize to park 10 taxi vehicles below Lans View Hotel by the orders of the CEO Lansdowne as authorized vide CBR NO. 12 dt 30-05-2016.

To consider and decide.

RESOLUTION: The notice be issued to parking contractor of Sadar Bazar Lansdowne area regarding collection of parking fee at the entry of the vehicle at Lansdowne. Whereas, he will charge parking fee only when the vehicle gets proper parked. If he does not comply orders, his contract shall liable to be terminated. The RI will inspect the matter frequently and will report to the CEO. Further, also resolved that to facilitate the general public/visitors of Lansdowne, the Board decided to exempt parking fee Rs. 2/- being charged on taxi vehicles as mentioned in agenda side. And the private vehicles will stand at site near Mayur hotel. The RI, Cantt Board will implement the same accordingly.

12. ATTENDANCE OF SENIOR CITIZENS AT DAY CARE CENTRE

The factual positions of attendance of senior citizens at day care centre during the month of May & June 2016 are placed on the table for consideration.

RESOLUTION: Noted. Further, resolved that examine the conditions whether the Library and Old Age Day Care Centre run in parallel with mutual understanding. The CEO is authorized to give his/her report on the matter.

13. GRANT OF DEARNESS RELIEF TO CANTT BOARD PENSIONERS.

The State Govt. of Uttarakhand has enhanced the rate of dearness allowance from 119 % to 125% to their pensioners' w.e.f 01-01-2016 vide Uttarakhand G.O 101/ XXVII(7)02/2010 dt 04-05-2016.

The pensioners of this Board are entitled as per Memorandum of the Settlement and NIT award to get the same rate of DA as specified by the State Govt. shall mutatis mutandis be made applicable to the Cantonment Board pensioners in the State from the same date as in the case of State Govt. pensioners.

The financial implication due to increase in DR will be Rs. 6,60,000 (Rs. 60,000 per month) per year approximately.

The provision for making payment of enhanced DR has already been provided in BE 2015-16(R)

The State Govt. GO mentioned above regarding terms and conditions is placed on the table.

RESOLUTION: Considered and recommended dearness relief to the Cantt Board pensioners at the rates 125% w.e.f 01-01-2016. The copy of the CBR be sent to the PD, DE, Central Command Lucknow.

14. EXTENSION FOR CHARTED ACCOUNTANT ON CONTRACT BASIS WEF. 01 JUNE 2016 TO 31 AUGUST 2016

The contract of the C.A. was expired on 31/07/2015 and half of the work of ABAS (Accrual Based Accounting System) is to be finalized for which C.A. was engaged on the basis of tender offered @ Rs. 19,000/- per month.

The work is still to be finalized along with the online application for accountancy and other related works to be completed further, as per instructions received from higher authorities. Hence, extension is required for further period of 03 months from 01 June 2016 to 31 August 2016.

To consider and approved.

RESOLUTION: The final extension is approved by the Board w.e.f 01-06-2016 to 31-08-2016 and fresh contract for engagement of Chartered Accountant be initiated.

15. REQUEST OF PARKING CONTRACTOR

Sh. Kuldeep Singh Negi, former contractor of Sadar Bazaar parking requested vide his letter No. nil dt 23-05-2016 that his security money of Rs. 20,000/- which was deposited by him vide Cantt 4-b receipt No. 657273 dt 08-04-2016, to take contract of collection rights of parking at Sadar Bazar area w.e.f 09-04-2016 to 31-03-2017.

Whereas he collected the parking fee only on 09-04-2016 and left the contract on 10-04-2016. As per the contract terms and conditions his security money may be forfeited if he fails to execute the contract for the defined period.

To consider and decide.

RESOLUTION: Considered in length and resolved considering the circumstances & reasons given by parking contractor security/earnest money be refunded after depositing fine of Rs. 5,000/-.

16. CHANGE OF PURPOSE

Sy. No. 199/104 situated at Sadar Bazaar area held in the name of Sh. Ajay Agarwal, Sh. Atul Agarwal sons of Sh. Radhey Krishna Agarwal on lease in Sch VI of CLAR 1925. Sh. Ajay Agarwal & Sh. Atul Agarwal have applied for change of purpose of the site for hotel/commercial, whereas at present the site is given for dwelling house as per GLR.

It is proposed to forward the case with recommendations to PDDE CC Lucknow to accord necessary sanction/direction in the matter.

Concerned file along with all documents is placed on the table.

RESOLUTION: Discussed in length and decided that pend the matter and no permission will be issued for running of hotel till the hotel bye-laws prepared by the Cantt Board with the help of expertise in the field. The R.I. and S.I. Cantt Board will inspect unauthorized running of hotels and issue notices with imposing fines to such defaulters.

Further, resolved that the notices be issued to the existing hoteliers of Lansdowne to fix the room rate list at the doors of each existing room within hotel.

17. SALE PURCHASE OF PROPERTY:-

The HOR has applied for sanction of sale- purchase of the property comprising Sy. No. The property is situated in the notified Bazaar area of Lansdowne Cantt and is under the management of Cantt Board. As per condition 1(8) of lease in Schedule VI of CLAR 1925, permission of sale purchase of the property is mandatory.

The Board has decided vide Board resolution no. 25 dated 19-02-2016, to refer the matter sent to Cantt Board legal advisor for legal advises. Copy of opinion by the legal advisor dated 21/4/2016 is placed on the table. The co-leasees Shri Manoj Rawat and Mukesh Kumar Rawat vide application dated 2/5/16 gave representation that the whole property be mutated in their name (after removing the names of Smt Sarojini Devi and Sonia Devi) and cancel the CBR no. 12 dated 31/12/2015. The whole matter with concerning documents was referred to Cantt Board legal advisor vide this office letter no. 199/70 / CB dated 11/5/2016. The Cantt Board legal advisor vide his opinion dated 24 / 5/ 2016 opined if objectors had any objection against mutation in favour of Smt Sarojini Devi and Sonia Devi during August 2015, they should have presented appeal before appellate authority against the order of the Board but it has not been done and now it is time barred and more over during 1/1/2002 after the death of Shri Roshan Singh, Smt Sarojini Devi and Sonia Devi have not relinquished their rights on the property. Hence no action can be taken on the request dated 2/5/2016 of Shri Manoj Rawat and Mukesh Kumar Rawat.

Concerned file along with all documents are placed on the table.

RESOLUTION: Instructions may be obtained on the matter from the office of the PD, DE, Central Command Lucknow.

18. PERMISSION TO GIFT THE PROPERTY SY NO. 79/6:-

Sy. No. 79/6 is held on old grant property in the names of Sh. Narendra Singh Rawat, Sh. Surendra Singh Rawat, Sh. Veer Singh Rawat, Sh. Anand Singh Rawat & Sh. Sain Singh Rawat Sons of late Sh. Dabal Singh Rawat in the 2/3 Bazaar area. Sh. Narendra Singh Rawat vide his application dated 27-06-2016 has applied permission for gift deed to be executed by Sh. Surendra Singh Rawat, Sh. Veer Singh Rawat, Sh. Anand Singh Rawat & Sh. Sain Singh Rawat Sons of late Sh. Dabal Singh Rawat in the favour of Sh. Narendra Singh Rawat.

RESOLUTION: Considered and approved mutation be carried out on the name of proposed HORs as per table in agenda side as a gift deed subject to deposit of prescribed mutation fee and execution of Admission & Declaration deed.

19. ELECTRICITY FEEDER LINES BY UPCL IN THE EVETT LINE & MAINWARING LINE BAZAAR:

It was brought in the notice that in the Evatt line & Main waring line bazaar. The electricity to the civil people is provided by MES & it is requested by Cantt Board member as well MES that a separate line these bazaar area may be constructed got through by UPCL authorities.

RESOLUTION: Considered and approved.

20. FRAMING OF BUILDING BYE-LAWS OF LANSDOWNE CANTONMENT

Reference PDDE letter no. 35281/Bye-laws/Build/LC7/2 dated 10-06-2016 along with DGDE letter no. 12/I/BLDG BYE-LAWS/GEN/DE/2015 dated 23-05-2016 & CBR No. 3 dated 07-01-2010. Building bye laws of Lansdowne Cantonment are required to amend as per modern living style requirements and step toward smart cities. The Board has to take action as per section 251 read with section 350 of the Cantonment Act 2006 Govt. has issued some guidelines for framing of building bye laws as per letter mentioned above.

It is proposed to constitute a committee containing CEO, GE, AE & Elected member & one town planner on contract basis.

RESOLUTION: Considered in length and decided that building bye-laws be prepared in the line of directions received from PD, DE, Central Command, Lucknow and DGDE, New Delhi. It is resolved that the Uttarakhand building bye-laws be compared along with Chakrata, Landour and other hill Cantonments before finalization and the CEO is authorize to engage 01 town planner on contract basis for the purpose of expert advice.

21. QUOTATIONS FOR PURCHASING COMPUTED RADIOGRAPHY SYSTEM AND X-RAY MACHINE

Ref CBR No. 25 dt 22 April 2016.

Vide above mentioned CBR it was proposed to call quotations to purchase a new X-ray machine 6 KW (160 ma) alongwith Computed Radiography System with an approximate expenditure of the machine is Rs. 1354500 /- with other expenses.

In response to this quotations called for wide publicity vide this office letter No. 1133/X-ray machine/16-17/CB dt 23 April 2016 and published in newspapers Hindustan and Amar Ujala and published on 01 May 2016 and 29 April 2016 respectively which was invited through E-procurement. Due date of opening was 20 May 2016.

Due to some changes in technical specification again a corrigendum published to call tenders vide this office letter No. 1133/X-ray machine/16-17/CB dt 19 may 2016 and published in newspapers Dainik Jagran and Amar Ujala and published on 21 May 2016. Due date of opening of which was 31 May 2016.

In response to this 04 Nos. tenders received in this office through e-procurement and their comparative statement prepared showing aggregate lowest rates of Rs. 10, 61,550/- with red underlined of M/s Viskho Corporation, Mayur Vihar Phase-II, Delhi-110096 which was forwarded to RMO, Cantt Gen Hospital, Lansdowne vide this office letter No. 1110/Med/2016-17/CB dt 04 June 2016 to check the specifications of the firms. In response to this RMO given its report vide letter No 03/Demand/2016-17/CB dt 07 June 2016.

The Comparative statement and relative documents are placed on the table for consideration.

RESOLUTION: Discussed and resolved that quotations recalled for purchase of X-ray machine along with computed radiography system.

22. PURCHASE OF BOLERO/SCORPIO

Ref CBR No. 32 dt 19-02-2016.

The Board vide above mentioned CBR approved for purchase the "Innova" diesel car on DGS&D or rates for Govt. departments in replacement of Staff Car. In response to this CBR proposal was sent to PDDE for sanction vide this office letter No. 2520/Veh/Staff Car/CB dt 05 Mar 2016. In response to this GOC-in-C, Central Command has disallowed the INNOVA staff Car vide their Dte letter No. 43376/Lansdowne/(I)/2014-15/LC5 dt 07 April 2016 and advised to send the proposal for some other model of Staff Car afresh in the financial year 2016-17 (R) and 2017-18 (O) indicating the model of the Car.

In response to this a fresh rate of the Scorpio S2 BS4 diesel Car has been enquired from Mahindra & Mahindra Ltd.

To consider the purchase of Scorpio S2 BS4 out of Depreciation Fund available with the Board Rs. 826218/- with other expenses and if rates goes higher than the Depreciation Fund available, remaining payment will be made from Cantt Fund.

RESOLUTION: Considered & approved purchase of Scorpio S2 BS4 at DGS&D rate of Rs. 8,26,218/- . The proposal be sent to PD,DE, CC, Lucknow for obtaining sanction.

23. REPRESENTATION OF SH. DINESH CHANDRA SINGH RAWAT, ELECTED MEMBER,- CANTT BOARD LANSDOWNE

Further, resolved that NOC be obtained for construction of Pathankot Road from GRRC Lansdowne. The CEO raised the point that the water is basic need of the people but due to distance of sub-main line charges of estimates accrued in higher side due to which people could not afford personal water connection. Hence, water sub main line of proportionate diameter be extended upto the proximate places in mohallas so that the estimates of water connection get reduced. The scheme be prepared for extension of water sub main line.

The enquiry be made for mutation advertisement cost from other Cantts whether it is borne by the Board or by proposed HORs.

Write a letter to SDM to make survey of BPL families at Lansdowne to provide facility under the BPL schemes to such families.
