TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. The proposed parking arrangement can be run on trail basis for one month if found suitable shall be continue and if found any discrepancies shall be altered or re-arranged accordingly.
2. Time being it can be run departmentally for 1 month if found suitable then auction proceeding/Leasing out shall be determined.
3. Vehicle register will be prepared by Contractor/employee mentioning total nos. of vehicle parked with Registration No. of vehicle, name of driver and owners.
4. The regulation of parked vehicle must be the duty of employee for day time i.e. up to 700 to 1900 hrs if run departmentally otherwise Contractor shall have responsibility of safety of the vehicles 24x7.
5. Regular checking by CEO, Rev. Inspector & authorized staff will be carried out if vehicle found parked against the rules and regulations will be penalized as per terms and conditions.
6. Temporary parking/stay where mention means for 1 hour.
7. Govt vehicles of any of the Deptt will be exempted for parking charges including vehicles of SSB, Indian Red Cross Society & Vehicles of Election Commission.
8. Elected members and Cantt Board Staff will be exempted from parking fees.
9. No vehicles shall be parked on Road sides except allotted/specified parking site.
10. If the Dependents of Local Residents comes Lansdowne will be charged rates as prescribed for the Local resident vehicles.
11. In the event of dispute between both the parties i.e. Contractor/Defaulter and CEO/PCB Lansdowne an arbitrator shall be appointed by common consent of both the parties.
12. The sole responsibility of theft or any natural calamities, mis-happening occurs will be of the owners/Drivers of the vehicle at any time.
13. The nature of serious offence/mis-happening will be decided by the Board or if any serious complications arises which will not be within the Board's edge will be forwarded to the next Competent Authority for decision and the decision binding on both the parties.
14. Legal jurisdiction will be within the local Courts or within the District Courts of Pauri.
15. These arrangements will be effective till a suitable place for parking could be developed or further orders issued otherwise shall be continue.
16. Penalty for any irregularities/breach of terms and conditions will be Rs 500/- which may be extended upto Rs. 1000/- for any continuous breach/violation of Regulations/Rules/Act applicable (Except Govt. Vehicles).
17. Any other terms and conditions can be imposed at later stage/execution of agreement with the contractor.

To consider and decide.

RESOLUTION : Considered and recommended as proposed in Agenda side of point No. 2 (2) erection of temporary shed be recommended to erect 34 feet length X 8 feet wide. Further also recommended that tea shop be erected of size 10X10 feet instead of 8X8 feet.

Revenue Inspector/SI authorized to initiate Challan proceeding against the defaulters.

Further also recommended that traffic plan be also sent to SDM, Lansdowne and local police authority along with SP, Police. S.P. Police may also be approached to depute traffic police to traffic place as assured by the SP Pauri.

02 employees may be employed to regulate the traffic place on contract basis as and when required for a period of 1-3 months as per requirement.

Volunteers be involved to regulate the traffic arrangement and awareness of General Public for the purpose students of each school can be motivated to send names of volunteers for the purpose once in a week.

Fine provision where mentioned will be charged from the contractor if the parking leased out on contract basis for any violation of regulation.

3. **REVISION OF PARKING RATES:**

In continuation of CBR No. 07 Dated 19-02-2016.

As the Board is heavily depending on Grants-in-aid from Central Govt. the dependency on grants due to increase in pay and allowances of employees and market index can be minimized to revise the rates. With a view to improve financial base to make provisions for developmental activities and for matter connected therewith and in exercise of the proviso to section 67 (g) of the Cantonment Act 2006. The Board shall for the purpose of this Act, revision of the following fee namely parking fee are proposed as under:

Further resolved that if the parking fee collection is auctioned then the Contractor will be the responsible to regulate parking and traffic regulations together otherwise penalty provision of Rs. 500/- and 1000/- mentioned will be charged /paid by the Contractor.

Where mentioned, penalty provision on defaulters/individual /vehicles in the CAC point No. 3-& 4 dated 27-10-2018 then the rule/ regulation will be applied on Contractor if the parking collection right goes on contract.

4. ALLOTMENT OF PLACE FOR ADVENTURE SPORTS:

An application received from Sh. Parvesh Budakoti dated Nil to run Adventure Sports activities in Cantt Area i.e. Green Field for a period of 8 months at a charge offered Rs. 70,000/-. Proposal submitted by him are as under:

1. The Applicant offered rent/ground rent of Rs. 70,000/- for a period of 8 Months in two installments. First installment of Rs. 35,000/- will be paid when permission to run the activities is allowed and second installment of Rs. 35,000/- after the completion of first 4 months.
2. Revenue sharing from the total income will also be done between the Cantt Board and Sh. Parvesh Budakoti, i.e, 30% to Cantt Board and 70% to Sh. Parvesh Budakoti. Expenses like Salary of Staff, Maintenance and Taxes would be paid by Sh. Parvesh Budakoti.

3. No damage would be done to the vegetation/Trees of the Cantt Area as most of the activities take place above the level of ground.
4. Only experienced staff will run the Adventure activities, and Proper Identification of the staff can be checked by any of the Competent Authorities.
5. Adventure Activities will be like Sky Bridge, Zip Line, Valley Crossing and Commando Net, Zorawing Wall etc.

The area he wants to run activities is "C Land" SY No. 147 under the management of Cantt Board placed under Section 122 of the Cantt Act 2006 for the purpose of revenue augmentation of the Board.

To consider and decide.

RESOLUTION : Considered and recommended.

5. PROPOSED HORSE RIDING ROUTE:

The Cantt Board Lansdowne is heavily State-aided Cantt Board and needs to abridge the dependency on grants the Board is planning to take initiatives for increasing revenue by starting small-small revenue generating activities which do not involve capital investment. Therefore, it is intended that horse riding route be marked within cantonment area to augment revenue of the Board as well as tourist will also be fascinated. The proposed routes are as under:

Route first: From Green Field (Civil Club) to Convent School Road to Old Church to Tif-In-Top to before Supply Band to Kacha Path jungle route to back of GMVN back gate to Tif-In-Top.

Second Route: Tif-In-Top to Old Church encircling to Mishra Bhawan to Bhula Lake.

As and when the Route will be decided by the Board such nature of Contractor/Service provider will be approached. Any other terms and conditions can be imposed at later stage/execution of agreement with the contractor. By the time the permission for the construction of temporary structure and use of land can be sought at B4 land near Tif-In-Top from DEO Meerut till then the Class C Land at Green Field available with the Board for temporary shelter for Horse and their owner can be used for the purpose.

To consider and decide.

RESOLUTION : Considered and recommended as proposed above . The Horse owners ensure that gunny bag will be fixed in horse manure in the back of horse. Further resolved that open ZYM/Fitness parks be developed in Cantonment area.

6. REPRESENTATION DATED 24-08-2018 OF SHRI. DINESH SINGH RAWAT, ELECTED MEMBER:

1. Civil area Committee Meeting should be conducted every month.
2. Regarding shortfall of medicine and Ultrasound Machine in Cantt General Hospital.
3. Enhancement of Scavenging and Tax, Quantity and Quality of goods in Cantt Board Store and Counting of Burans, Kafal, Oak and Devdar Tress in Cantt Area.
4. Contractors completed the assigned work within time or not, Quality of work maintained or not, and after completion of work payment made or not.
5. 7th Pay Commission DA Arrear of the Employees and Arrear of New Pension not paid.

6. No work carried out in “Shamshan Ghat” like Path, Roof and if Cantt Board not able to do the work may be given to another institution.
7. Regarding enhancement of Tax and Parking
8. Allotment of a room for the Members of the Board to resolve the public matters so that work execution of public related matters may be resolved.

RESOLUTION : (1) Civil Area Committee already conducted and in future regularly be conducted.

(2) CEO informed that supply order for supply of medicines already placed and some Medicines received in the hospital and remaining are to be received shortly. It is recommended that Lab technician and Pharmacist should not go on together. And also staff nurse and Mid wife should not go on leave together.

Further it is recommended that RMO will submit a report regarding PNDT Act Training by the CB Doctors as earlier approved by the Board.

(3) Shortly taxes will be revised as per triennial assessment. Further, resolved that store be maintained properly. Physical verification of the stores can be carried out as per provisions permits. Details of trees planted during last three years placed before CAC and CAC Satisfied.

(4) A.E. may be instructed accordingly.

(5) CEO informed that, 7th CPC Arrear has already been disbursed to the employees. Arrear of New Pension be paid as soon as possible as & when sufficient fund gets available.

(6) It is resolved that Hindu Burning Ghat Committee be constituted and submitted to this office for further action.

(7) Matter of revision of parking already placed before CAC at point No. 3 &4.

(8) Room for office already provided to elected members in Sadar Bazar area.

Further It is resolved that regular visit/surprise visit of S.I in the field of sanitation areas should be ensured. It is also resolved that Meat Stamp should be affixed on the slaughtered body of Goats and Sheep.
